LICENSE POINTS AND RULES

RULE 1: Boundaries

- Children are required to stay within the centre boundaries. (Top oval except near trees closest to hall)
- Basketball court but not bubblers
- OOSH rooms but not office (kitchen under staff supervision)
- Toilets only if informed a staff member and go in pairs
- Other areas as directed by staff but not playground equipment unless supervised constantly by staff. (School Rule)

Points lost for breach of rule: 3

RULE 2: Respect each other - words

- Children will need to speak nicely with each other – no teasing
- Children must not exclude each other from activities or conversations
- Children will need to speak nicely with younger children

Points lost for breach of rule: 1

RULE 3: Respect each other – physical

- Inappropriate physical behaviour of any kind
- Intentions of any inappropriate behaviour

Points lost for breach of rule: 3

RULE 4: Respect the staff

- Children must speak nicely to staff and vice versa

Points lost for breach of rule: 1

RULE 5: Respect the staff – serious

- Children must follow all staff instructions without argument

Points lost for breach of rule: 3

- Children must not hang off staff clothing, jump on staff backs or pull on staff arms at any time

Points lost for breach of rule: 4

Banana club additions and changes to consent for club participation 2012 and 2013

Changes to Points

Earning points back for outstanding achievements such as:

- Helping staff
- Helping to deliver the active after school care program
- Responsible behaviour
- Keeping the club tidy after everyone else has left for the day

Changes to Point deductions

- Disrespecting centre or equipment 1 point
- Disrespecting the environment 3 points
- Leaving a mess behind at the end of a session 2 points
- Disrespecting Staff 3 points
- Members must attend active kids on one day of the week
- Members can be immediately suspended for inappropriate behaviour for 1 week. After this time members will need to earn all 12 point back in order to return to the banana club.
 - Swearing
 - Bullying behaviour
 - Calling children names
 - Calling staff names
 - Refusing to listen to staff instructions
 - Hurting another child or staff member
 - Misbehaving on excursions or during incursions

GENERAL EXPECTATIONS OF MEMBERS

1. All children will be expected to sign off on the roll – supervised by staff, apply sunscreen, wash hands and then collect their afternoon tea in the afternoon session. Club members will be expected to sit down to eat. Children will need to wait till seconds is called before lining up for more food.
2. It is the shift supervisor's role to ensure all club members have arrived at OOSH as per centre policy.
3. Club members will also be expected to attend roll call as required to hear important updates or changes to centre routines.
4. Club members are allowed to write to the committee should they be unhappy with any issues or decisions made by staff.
5. Club members are reminded that the club can be closed during any given session if staff feels there are unresolvable issues requiring further discussions.
