Ryde East Vacation Care Information

General Information

At **Ryde East Vacation Care**, we aim to provide your children with the best and safest care whilst engaging them in fun, exciting and educational activities. Dec 2019 Vacation Care will run on Thursday 19th & 20th Dec. Jan vacation care will run from Mon 6th to 28th Jan 2020.

Parking is available in the Badajoz Road car park, off Twin Road.

Hours of Operation: 7 am – 6 pm daily during Vacation Care including the Pupil Free Day (Closed on Public Holidays).

Please note that families who are not currently enrolled in the centre will need to complete an on-line enrolment.

Bookings: Bookings are now open online and will close on Sunday 15th Dec 2019 midnight after this date booking can be made by contacting the centre. Bookings from 16th Dec will incur an additional fee of \$10 each day.

Fee Structure: *PRIOR* to attending vacation care all fees must be paid in full with a receipt attached, or your booking cannot be accepted.

Payment options are Internet banking or direct deposit at the branch. Please refer to our booking form or our program for the cost of each day. There is an annual membership fee of \$25 per family. A CRN must be supplied for the enrolling parent and all children attending the service. Our bank account details are:

Cancellations: All bookings are non-refundable. Based on approval, a booking may be transferred within the same week. However, any difference between the costs of the days must be paid prior to the day. No refund will be given for a cheaper day.

Banana Club: Banana Club is a group for our Year 5 & 6 children. We aim to provide stimulating and age appropriate activities for these children, to ensure they are engaged and having fun. This includes giving them more freedom within the centre. If you have a child in year 5 or 6 who is new to the centre, please ensure you sign a Banana Club consent form.

Vacation Care Essentials

Meals: Breakfast is served each day until 8:15 am. We provide morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea on the days we stay at the Centre. Parents must supply all healthy meals and drinks including water bottles on excursions (unless otherwise stated on the program). Due to the severity of some children's allergies, Ryde East is nut free. We would appreciate you don't send your child with any nut products.

What to Bring:

- A backpack
- A hat
- Spare clothes
- Wet weather gear
- Sun smart clothes
- Enclosed shoes e.g. joggers, runners or sports shoes
(no thongs)

Note: Children are responsible for their own belongings, the Centre will not be held responsible for the loss of property.

Excursion Essentials

All children must be at the Centre no later than **the time provided on the vacation care sheet for an excursion**, unless otherwise stated. It is important that the children are given clear boundaries and guidelines for excursions and incursions. All children will be required to wear a Ryde East OOSH hat on the day of excursions. Children will not be permitted to make any other purchases during excursions, so please do not supply your children with any extra money – unless otherwise specified in the program. Transport will be a combination of public bus, private bus and walking.

Further Information

The Centre reserves the right to make changes to the program without notice, including cancellation of programs due to insufficient numbers or extreme weather conditions.

Ryde East is a fun, safe and happy place for everyone. Bullying, bad language and harassment of staff and other children will not be tolerated. The centre Director reserves the right to cancel a participant's enrolment should their behaviour be deemed unacceptable.
